Parents Bill of Rights for Data Privacy and Security

Handicapped Children's Association - DBA Helping Celebrate Abilities (HCA) seeks to use current technology, including electronic storage, retrieval, and analysis of information about students' education experience in the agency, to enhance the opportunities for learning and to increase the efficiency of our operations. To assist in meeting legal requirements for maintaining the privacy and security of protected student data and protected director and teacher data, including Section 2-d of the New York State Education Law, HCA has posted this Parents Bill of Rights for Data Privacy and Security.

- (1) A student's personally identifiable information cannot be sold or released for any commercial purposes.
- (2) Parents have the right to inspect and review the complete contents of their child's education record.
- (3) State and federal laws protect the confidentiality of personally identifiable information, and safeguards associated with industry standards and best practices, including but not limited to, encryption, firewalls, and password protection, must be in place when data is stored or transferred.
- (4) A complete list of all student data elements collected by the State is available at http://www.nysed.gov/data-privacy-security/student-data-inventory and a copy may be obtained by writing to the Office of Information & Reporting Services, New York State Education Department, Room 863 EBA, 89 Washington Avenue, Albany, New York 12234.
- (5) Parents have the right to have complaints about possible breaches of student data addressed.
