

QUICK COVID Reference.

Mask Requirements

- Masks are optional based on personal preference.
- Wear a mask if you are moderately/ severely immune-compromised; as directed by personal medical professional
- Wear a mask for personal comfort, be respectful of personal preference
- Wear a mask if classroom, school, city, county, or state requirements change based on transmission rates

All **POSITIVE COVID test results** must be received by HCA in photo form or from a physician.

Rapid Antigen or PCR tests are acceptable/ Home COVID tests will also now be accepted for a return to school.

Day 0 is the day of a positive test; Day 1 is the day following the day of the positive test.

Day 0 is the first day symptoms begin; Day 1 is the first full day following onset of symptoms.

<p>Fully Vaccinated with symptoms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wear a mask for 10 days • COVID test on day 5 recommended • If given, please submit negative test to school • If unable to mask, quarantine for 10 days from date of exposure. 	<p>Unvaccinated with symptoms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wear a mask for 10 days • COVID test on day 5 recommended • If given, please submit negative test to school • Symptoms must be improving and fever free for 24 hours with no medication • If unable to mask, quarantine for 10 days from date of exposure.
<p>If COVID symptoms are present STAY HOME COVID Test Return when symptoms are improved for 24 hours without medication.</p>

ILLNESS	
<p>Out sick or sent home with COVID-like symptoms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can return with alternative diagnoses from physician • COVID test on day 5 of onset of symptoms recommended • If given, submit negative test to school • Symptoms must be improving and fever free for 24 hours with no medication to return 	<p>Positive COVID Test</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Isolate for 5 days from <u>date of test</u> • Symptoms improving and fever free for 24 hours with no medication • Wear a mask for 5 days following isolation. • If unable to mask, quarantine for 10 days from date of exposure.
<p>If child has a release from the doctor, child can return to school on the date specified by the doctor.</p>
